1.0 INTRODUCTION

3.0 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- a. Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation issued by Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CAC1.1 or CAC2 and CAC7. Business Name is also acceptable for Services;
- b. Evidence of Company's Income Tax Clearance Certificate (or Personal Income Tax Clearance Certificates of all the Partners in case of Business Name) for the last three (3) years (2018, 2019 & 2020) valid till 31st December, 2021.
- c. Evidence of current Pension Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021;
- d. Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021;
- e. Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021;
- f. Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/12/2021 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.
- g. Sworn Affidavit:
 - disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Energy Commission of Nigeria or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars
 - that the company is not bankrupt, in receivership or under liquidation or involved in any litigation which can potentially affect the company's ability to effectively discharge their responsibility if engaged;
 - that none of the Company's Directors has been convicted of any crime relating to procurement fraud in any Country;
- h. Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years - (2018, 2019 & 2020);
- i. Company Profile with Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic /Professional qualifications such as COREN, QSRBN, CORBON, ARCON etc.;
- j. Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- k. Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects;
- l. Category B: Evidence of Firm's current registration with relevant regulatory Professional Body(ies);
- m. Evidence of Current NEMSA License for contractors in the Electric Power Sector issued by the Nigeria Electricity Management Services Agency (NEMSA) for those applying for the installation of Transformers in lots 58, 59, 66 and 69.
- n. For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (CAC, Tax Clearance Certificate, Pension Compliance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Compliance Certificate, IRR & Sworn Affidavit are compulsory for each JV partner);

 - We will also ensure that relevant Civil Society Organization and Professional Bodies are present to observe the exercise in compliance with Section 19 of the PPA, 2007.
